





Adults with **Associate Degrees** or Higher


Percentage working-age adults, by race and ethnicity, 2014





Adults with **High-Quality Postsecondary Credentials**


Percentage working-age adults, southern region, 2008-2014





Unemployment Rates and Median Weekly **Earnings**


By education level in U.S., 2015

So far, what do we know?


- Goal on postsecondary attainment rate involves workingage adults
- High-quality certificates add 3 5 percentage points to attainment
- About 43% of working-age adults have postsecondary credentials
- Little progress on the goal since 2008


K-12 Enrollment **Growth**






Public K-12 Enrollment

Percentage under 18 living in poverty, 2014



Percentage eligible for free or reduced-price meals






So now, what more do we know?

It's harder to do the job, particularly to do it well


- Strains on school's financial resources

- Need to help more struggling families







Student engagement in school matters.



Percentage scoring at or above NAEP Proficient






Percentage scoring at or above NAEP Proficient



Percentage scoring at or above NAEP Proficient




High School Graduation Rates




SREB states where 100% of seniors took the ACT











Rate of recent HS graduates enrolling, Fall 2014








6-Year College Graduation Rates

Fall 2008 first-time, full-time freshmen at public 4-year colleges and universities (2014)




6-Year College Graduation Rates


