Commitment to Implementing SREB Readiness Courses

The leadership at _____ will implement the SREB Readiness Courses with fidelity, using teachers who have received training at the Readiness Courses Institute. - Assign teachers to Readiness Courses who have completed the training. Require them to complete the initial training and online follow-up training.
- Ensure proper placement of students into the Readiness Courses. These courses are designed for students who are close to meeting the college readiness benchmarks. These courses are not designed for students who are at the lowest levels of academic preparation. Schools may refer to state readiness standards to determine student placement.
- Support teachers in follow-up training and documentation of effectiveness. This includes participation in online support and collecting evidence of student success.

Commitment to Becoming an SREB Ready Certified School

Stipend Agreement

Each teacher is eligible for a \$700 stipend, which will be paid upon completion of the training. The \$350 registration fee must be paid at the time of registration for the Readiness Courses Institute. To receive the training stipend, teachers must participate in training, which is scheduled for 8 a.m. until 4 p.m. CST July 10 – 13, 2017. Travel arrangements should be made accordingly, arriving before July 10 and departing no earlier than 4 p.m. July 13.
