Naples, Florida — June 30, 2015 — Governor Asa Hutchinson of Arkansas was elected chair of the Southern Regional Education Board at the organization's annual meeting in Naples, Florida.

As chair of SREB's 80-member Board, Governor Hutchinson will work with other governors, legislators and state education leaders to pursue goals for improving public education and student achievement across the region at every level, from early childhood through doctoral education. Board chairs are elected to one-year terms.

Glen D. Johnson, chancellor of the **Oklahoma** State Regents for Higher Education was elected vice chair of the Board. He chairs SREB's Commission on College Affordability in the South, which will report recommendations in 2016. He joined the SREB Board in 2010.

Senator **Robert H. Plymale** of Huntington, **West Virginia**, was re-elected for a third term as treasurer of the Board. A member of the West Virginia legislature since 1993, he has been an SREB Board member since 2003.

Representative **Tom Dickson** of Varnell, **Georgia**, was elected chair of SREB's Legislative Advisory Council at the group's annual Legislative Work Conference, held in conjunction with the SREB annual meeting. Dickson has served on the Legislative Advisory Council since 2008 and succeeds state senator Joyce Elliott of Arkansas as chair of the group.
