

Making SREB's Surveys Work for Your School

The SREB surveys provide an opportunity to collect authentic and anonymous student and teacher feedback. These surveys provide a snapshot of where a school is in relation to SREB's research-based school improvement framework. The student surveys ask about students' classroom experiences, expectations of their learning environment and postsecondary and career goals. Teacher surveys explore the level of support from school leadership, teachers' views about improving student achievement and expectations of students. The goal of these surveys is to translate data into action so that student outcomes can improve.

General Information

- Surveys are administered to all (or a random sample of 60) seniors at technology centers and high schools and eighth grade students at middle grades schools.
- Surveys are administered to all full- and part-time teachers.
- Surveys are administered online.
- Surveys are administered over a one-month period each spring and can be completed at any time during this administration window.
- All schools will receive user-friendly, actionable feedback reports after survey administration is complete.



What is the value of the SREB Surveys?

- Allow schools to establish baseline data, identify areas of strength and areas needing improvement and track progress over time
- Allow schools to compare their current standings with all schools and similar schools
- Show student and teacher responses in several indices that are proven predictors of student performance including:
 - **Integrated curricula and assignments** that utilize real-world problems and projects
 - **Challenging and engaging instructional strategies** in all classrooms
 - **Access to quality career pathway experiences** for all students, including underrepresented and nontraditional students
 - **A seamless transition** from the middle grades to high school and from high school to postsecondary institutions
 - A challenging and supportive school climate of **high expectations**
 - A tiered and targeted system of extra help, **enrichment and interventions** based on student needs
 - **Guidance and advisement** that helps students prepare for college and careers
 - School leadership and an emphasis on a culture of **continuous school improvement**
