29th Annual Institute on Teaching and Mentoring

The 2022 Institute on Teaching and Mentoring remained the largest gathering of minority doctoral Ph.D. students in the nation with **958** attendees. The Institute brings together students and faculty members from across the nation. This year there were 322 SREB attendees, 18 McNair attendees, 184 Sloan attendees, 44 Gates attendees, 31 presenters, 217 recruiter representatives, 99 Guests, 26 NASA attendees, 9 SSRC attendees, 8 others (staff and administrators).
