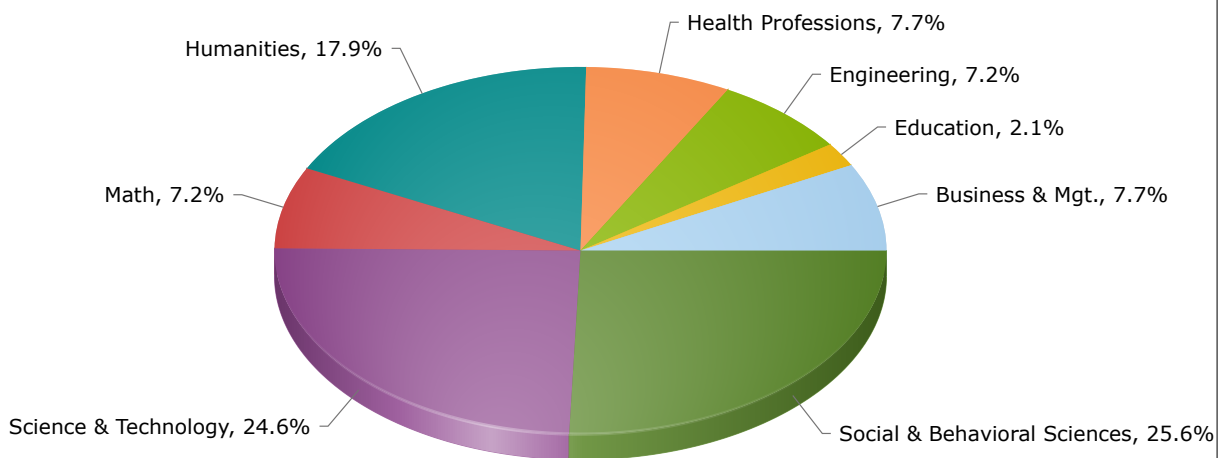

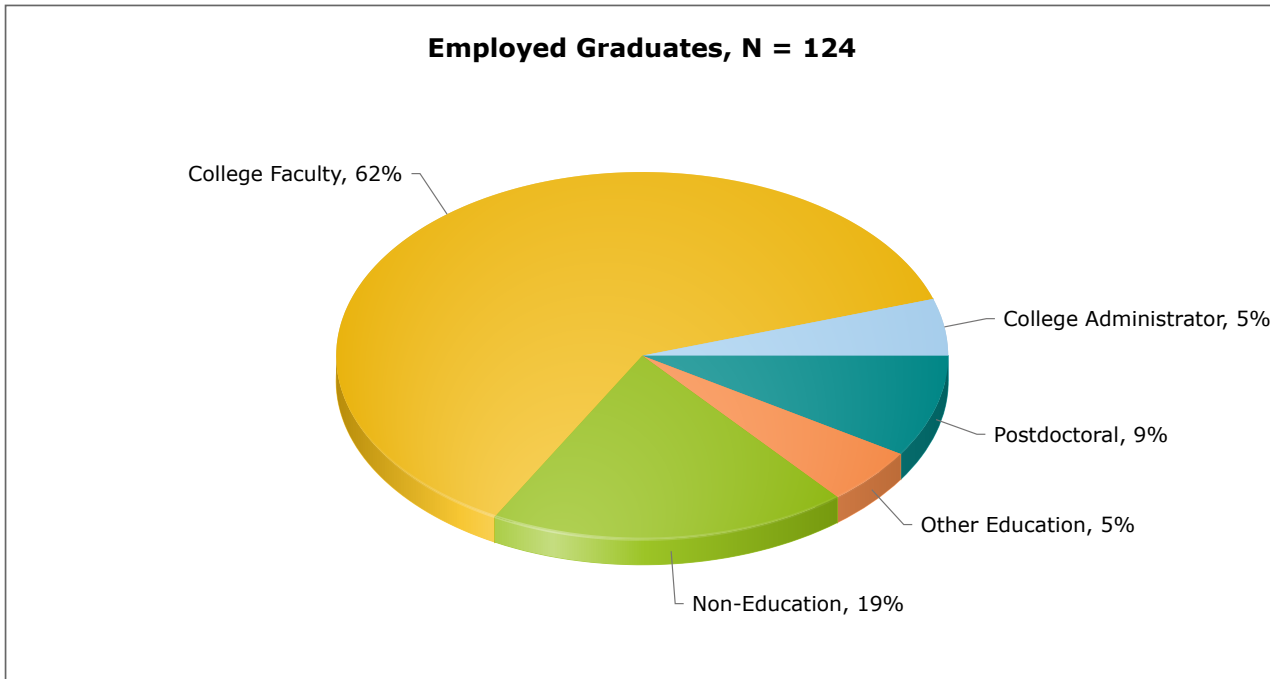

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Alabama Graduate Profile as of 01/15/20

- 142 graduates (90 doctoral scholars; 52 dissertation scholars)
- 31 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 77 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.7 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 5.1 years for doctoral scholars (5.1 years average with master's degree; 5.8 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 34.2 years



- 81 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 95 percent are in higher education
- 73 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
