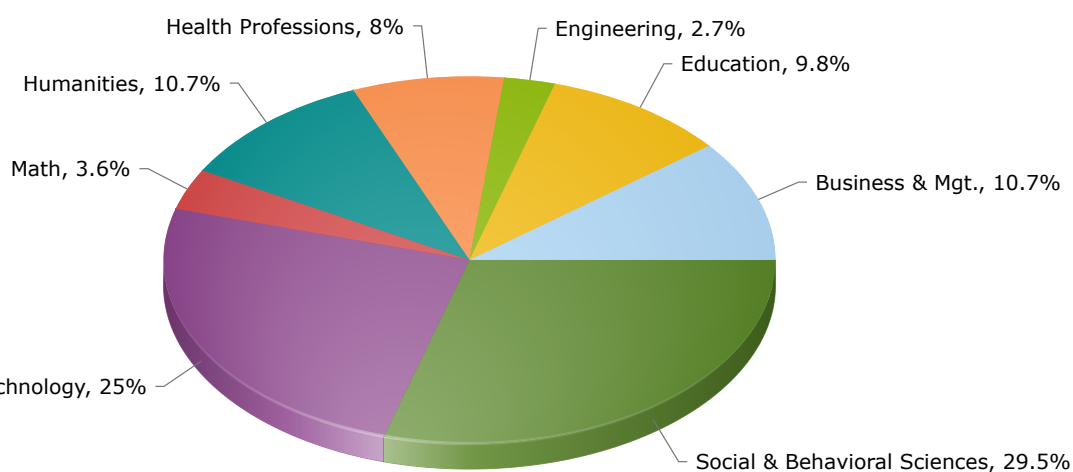

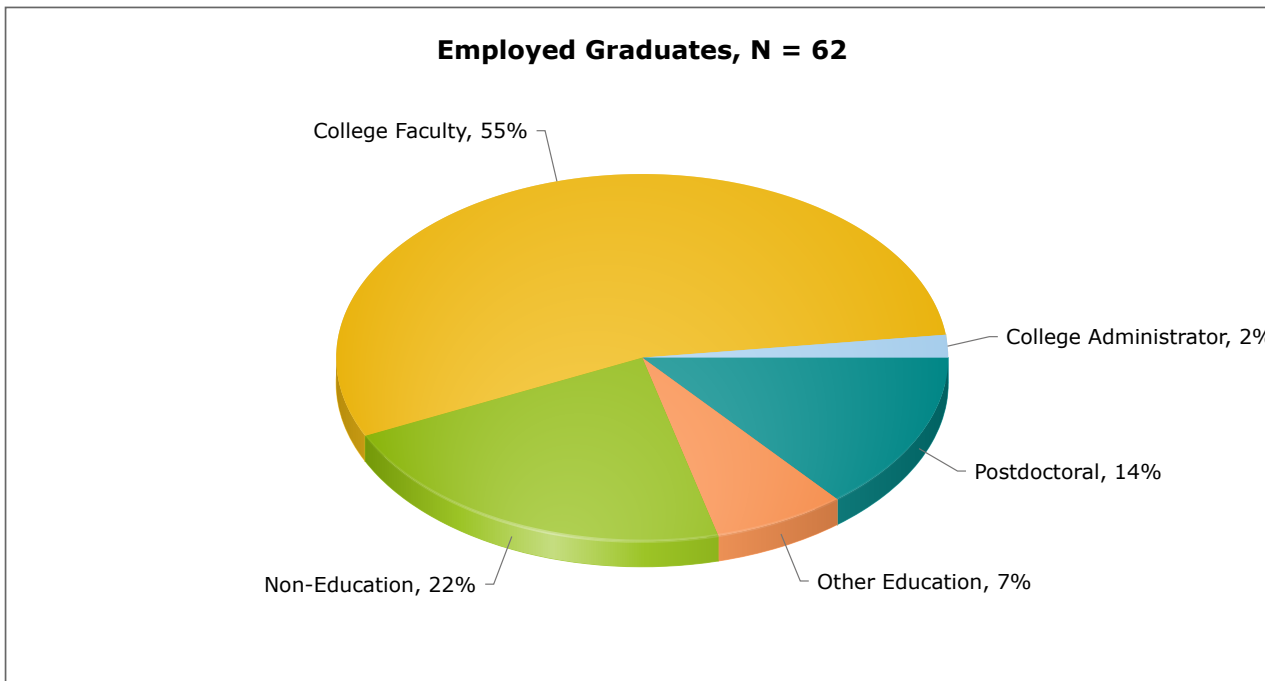

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Arkansas Graduate Profile as of 01/22/20

- 75 graduates (58 doctoral scholars; 17 dissertation scholars)
- 0 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 81 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 2.2 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.8 years for doctoral scholars (4.8 years average with master's degree; 4.7 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 35.4 years



- 71 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 86 percent are in higher education
- 71 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
