



## SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Arkansas Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 78 graduates (61 doctoral scholars; 17 dissertation scholars)
- · 24 percent received a bacccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 81 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 2.2 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.7 years for doctoral scholars (4.8 years average with master's degree; 4.2 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 35.4 years



- 71 percent of graduates are employed in education
  87 percent are in higher education
- 71 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
