

Description of Services Direct Services

Site Coordinator	<i>HSTW</i> recommends that each school select a teacher to serve as the site coordinator. Schools determine the appropriate remuneration (most give a specific stipend).
Literacy Coach	Literacy coaches provide professional development and support to all teachers as they implement instructional strategies that focus on increasing literacy achievement. <i>HSTW</i> recommends teachers have at least two (2) periods per day (one block) to serve as the coach.
Numeracy Coach	The same guidelines as for the Literacy Coach with a focus on numeracy across the curriculum.
Orientation Workshop	Two-days of on-site support — presentations to teachers, students, parents and local boards of education — for schools introducing the <i>HSTW</i> design to all constituents.
Site Development Workshop	Two-day workshop for all teachers to develop action teams and determine initial steps in the implementation of the <i>HSTW</i> design.
Technical Assistance Visit	Three-day audit of school and classroom practices using a team including <i>HSTW</i> staff, teachers, community members, principals and state department of education employees. A report of findings is created and provided to school and district leaders.
Coaching	On-site support to school leaders and teachers in implementing the HSTW design.
Professional Development	Focused on improving instruction through the use of literacy and numeracy strategies or other topics identified by the technical assistance visit and/or school improvement plan.
HSTW Assessment	A NAEP referenced assessment including three subject tests (reading, mathematics and science), a student survey and a senior survey. A minimum of 60 seniors (100 recommended) participate in the biennial <i>HSTW</i> Assessment, and all teachers complete the teacher survey.
Summer Conference & National Workshops	Team of educators to attend the annual three-day <i>HSTW</i> Staff Development Conference held each July. Teacher teams are invited attend various national workshops focused on improving instruction in classrooms
District Leadership Coordination	Annual meeting with district leaders to present progress made by the school and to coordinate continued improvement efforts.
SREB/School Improvement Materials	Materials for the development of a professional library that includes all recent SREB publications.
