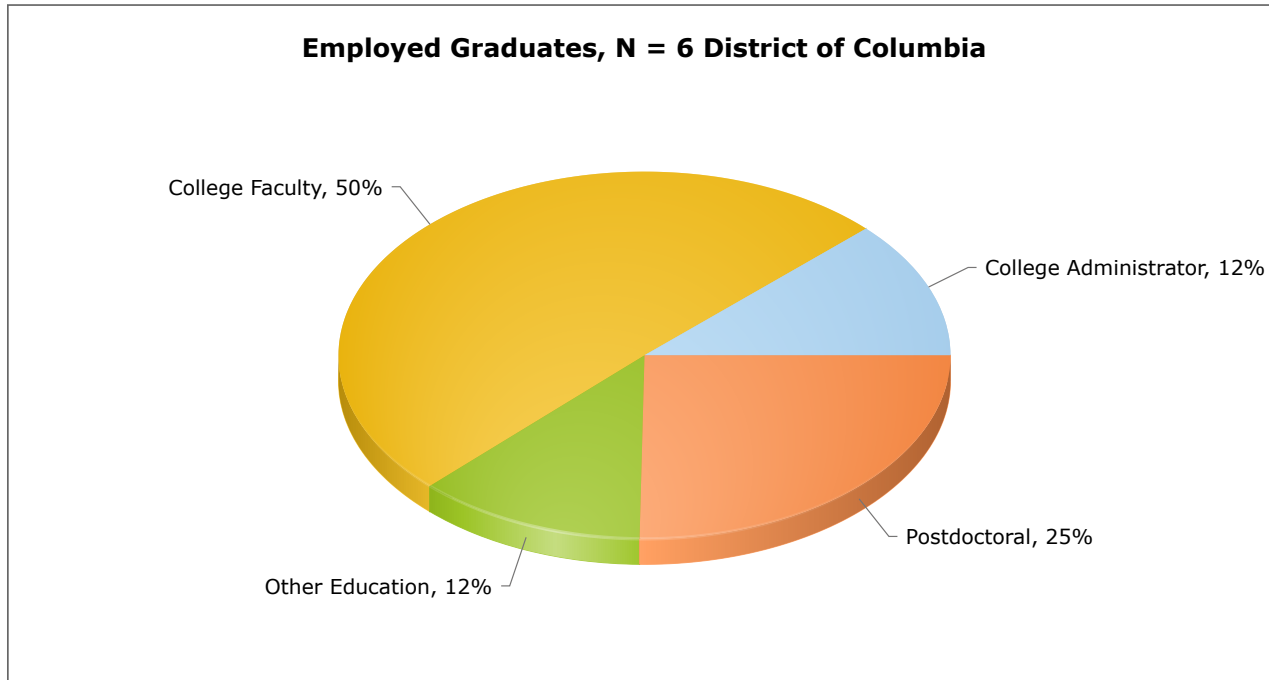


SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program District of Columbia Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 8 graduates (7 doctoral scholars; 1 dissertation scholars)
- 38 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 91 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.2 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 3.0 years for doctoral scholars (3.0 years average with master's degree; 0.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 34.8 years



- 100 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 83 percent are in higher education
- 50 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states

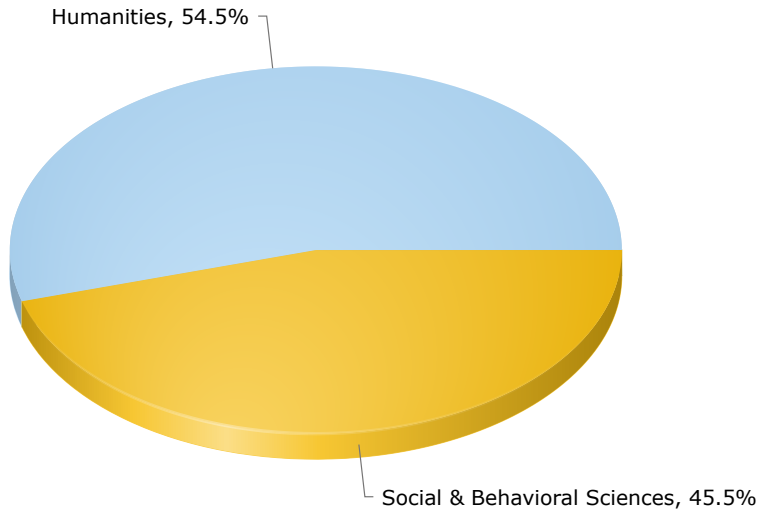
