




Public Elementary and Secondary Enrollment








Responding Institutions Offering Doctorate in Nursing







ADN Enrollees by Full-Time/Part-Time Status




Bachelor's Enrollees by Full-Time/Part-Time Status






ADN Enrollees by Gender




BSN Enrollees by Gender






ADN and **BSN** Enrollees by Race/Ethnicity










New Bachelor's Matriculants by Program (N=16,424)



- Jobs for nurses have diversified. BUT:
 - Most RNs remain in traditional hospital staff positions
 - Just over half of RNs work in hospitals
 - One-in-five work in insurance, pharmaceuticals, regulatory areas.
- Nurses in advanced specialty positions work longer hours than other nurses.
- Although LPN/LVN to RN transition programs exist, only about 18 percent of existing

RNs were previously LPNs/LVNs.

Twice as many RNs have a BSN or higher as have an ADN/ASN or less.
















Kentucky Nursing Career Pathway -





Nursing Faculty by Gender







