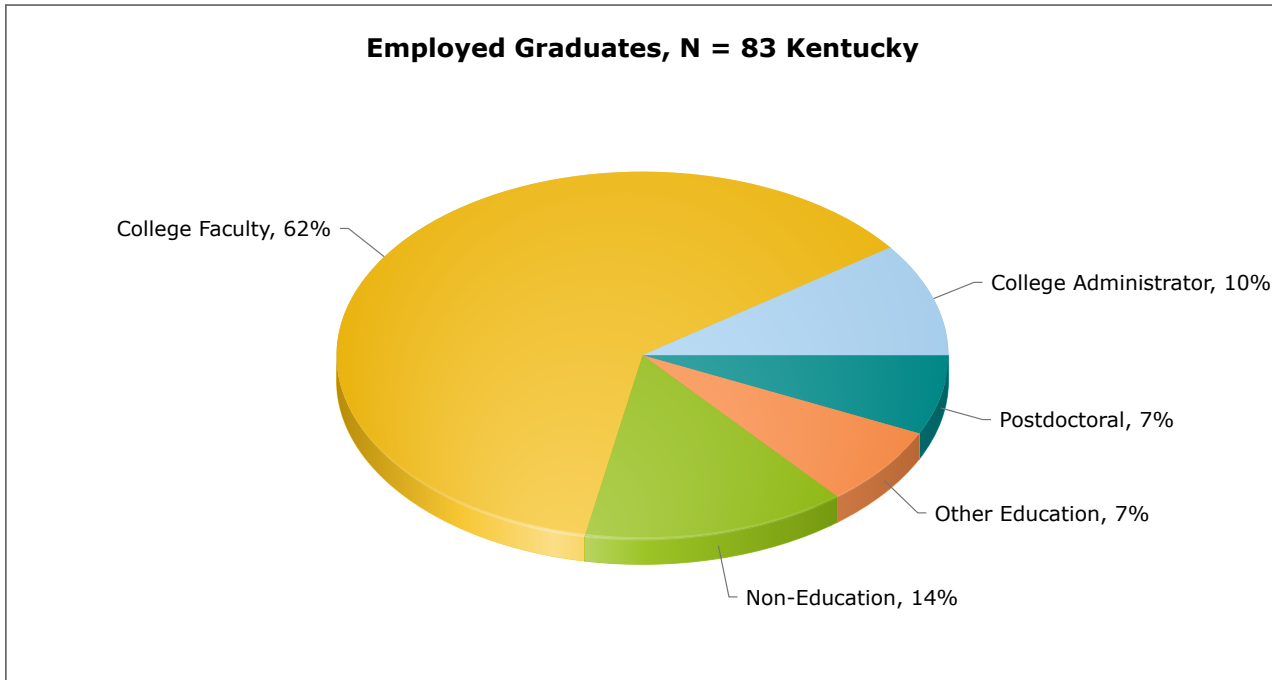


SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Kentucky Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 101 graduates (58 doctoral scholars; 43 dissertation scholars)
- 30 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 79 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 2.0 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.7 years for doctoral scholars (4.6 years average with master's degree; 5.1 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 36.2 years



- 82 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 93 percent are in higher education
- 65 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states

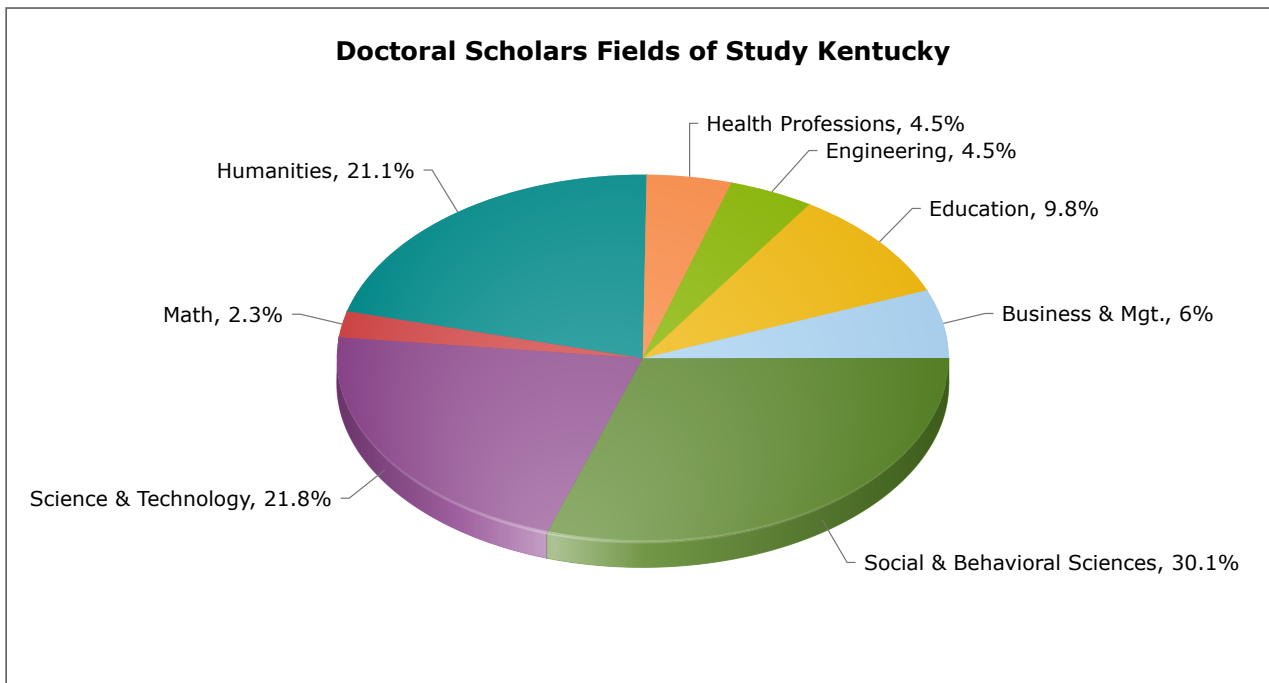
