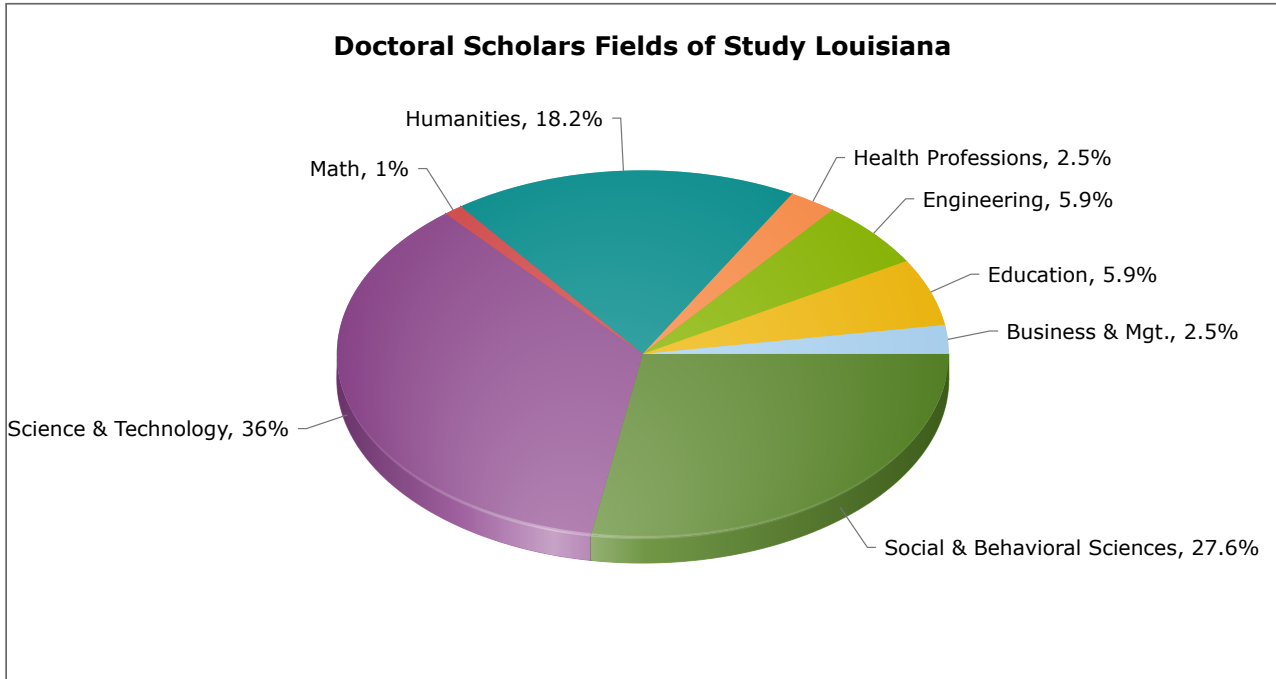

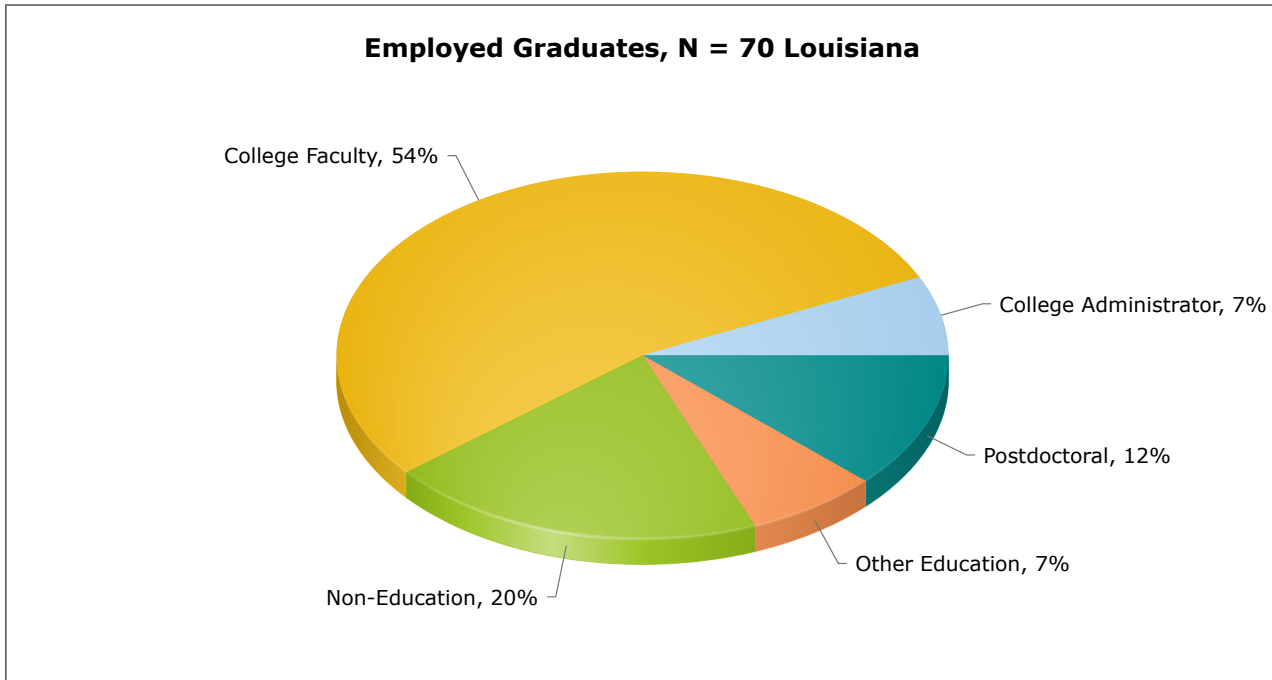

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Louisiana Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 86 graduates (82 doctoral scholars; 4 dissertation scholars)
- 33 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 55 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.8 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.8 years for doctoral scholars (4.7 years average with master's degree; 4.9 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 32.3 years



- 81 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 93 percent are in higher education
- 74 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
