CCCOER-Advisory listserv is a public discussion list intended for community college faculty, librarians, instructional designers, administrators, and other educators who are interested in open education policy, practices and resources. It serves three main purposes:

- A listserv to share ideas, resources and best practices pertaining to OER.
- A communication channel for sharing events and professional development opportunities for OER adoption at community colleges.
- A source of key updates about policy, research, projects and other news from the broader OER movement.

Instructions for joining a group:

1. Sign in to [Google Groups](#). [Learn how to join if you don't have a Google Account](#).
2. In the box at the top, enter a subject, like "cooking" or "football." To browse groups by category or region, click **Browse all**. Depending on what you search for, you might see a list of groups followed by a list of messages.
3. Optional: If a group is open, you can read messages sent by its members by clicking the group name.
4. To join a group, click **Join group** or **Apply to join group**. If a group is invite-only, you can ask to be invited by clicking **Contact owner**.

After you've joined the group, you'll get a confirmation email. If you applied or contacted the owner, that means your application needs to be approved.
