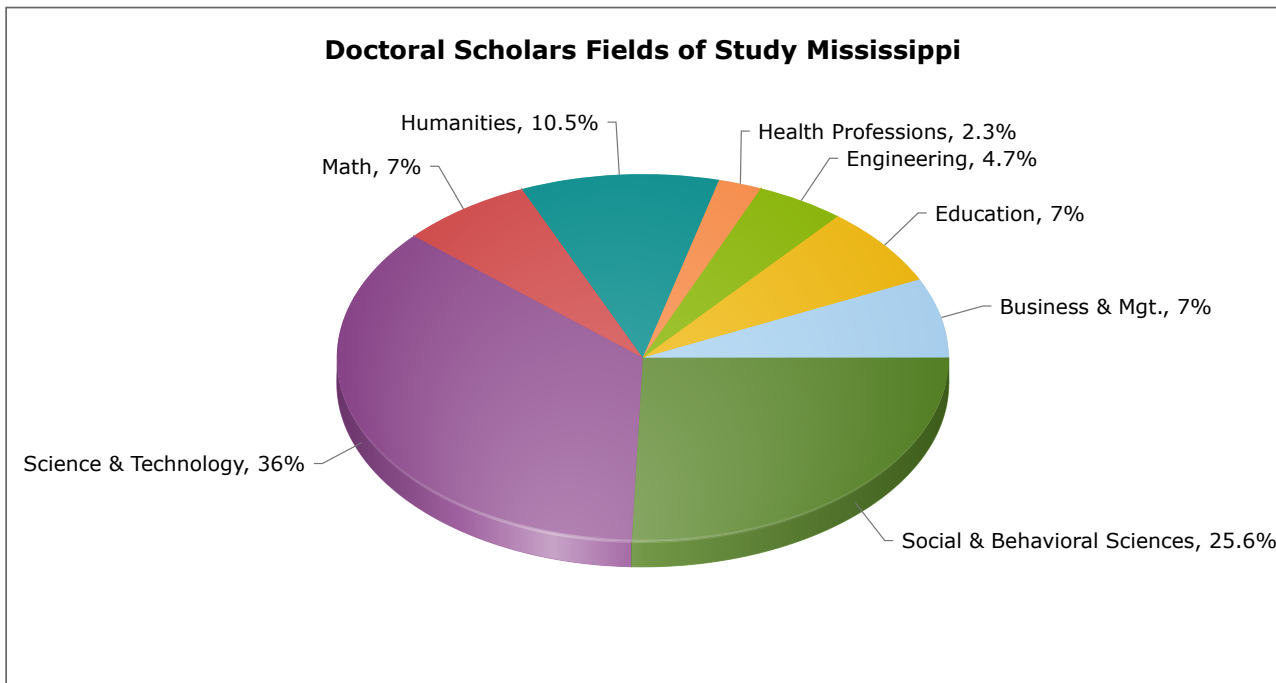

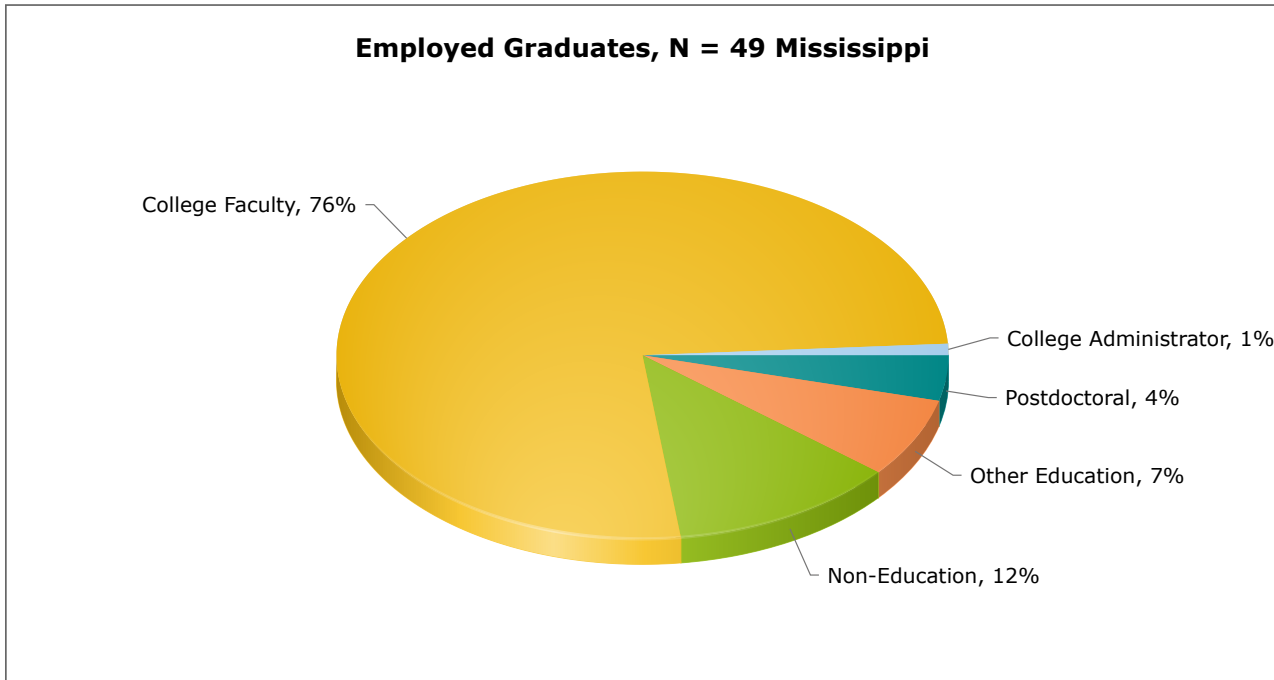

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Mississippi Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 55 graduates (46 doctoral scholars; 9 dissertation scholars)
- 60 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 78 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 2.4 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 5.0 years for doctoral scholars (5.0 years average with master's degree; 5.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 33.8 years



- 84 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 93 percent are in higher education
- 78 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
