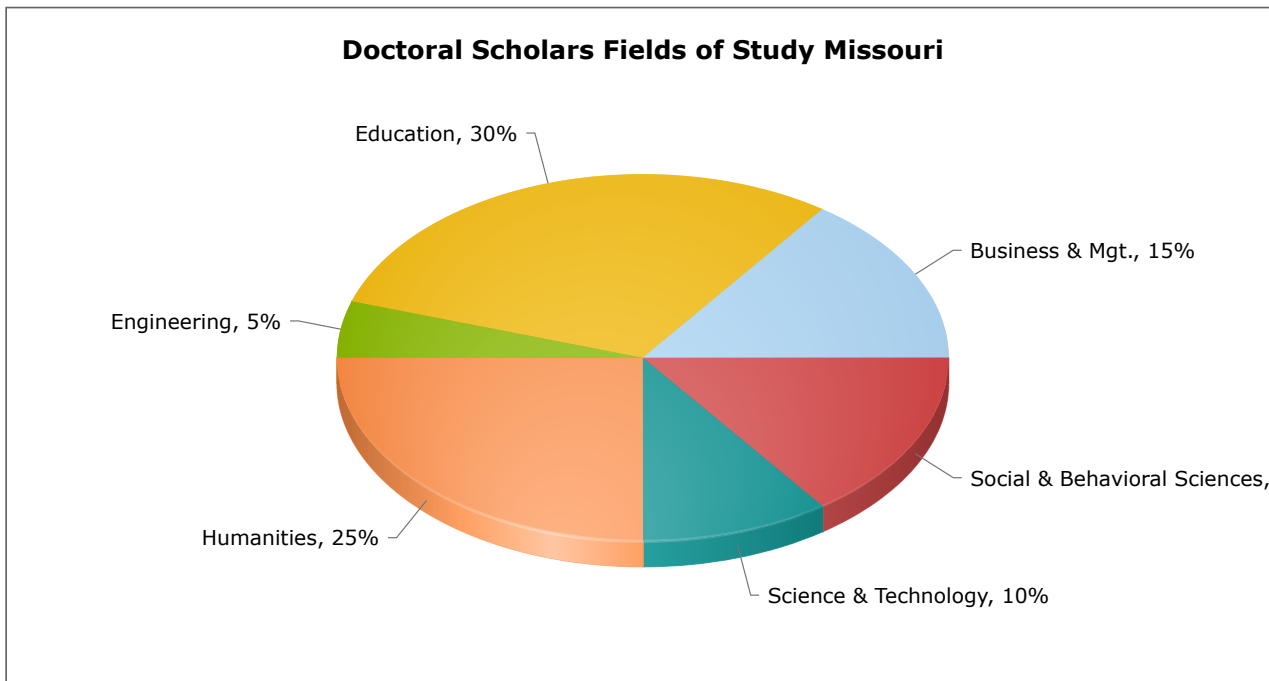

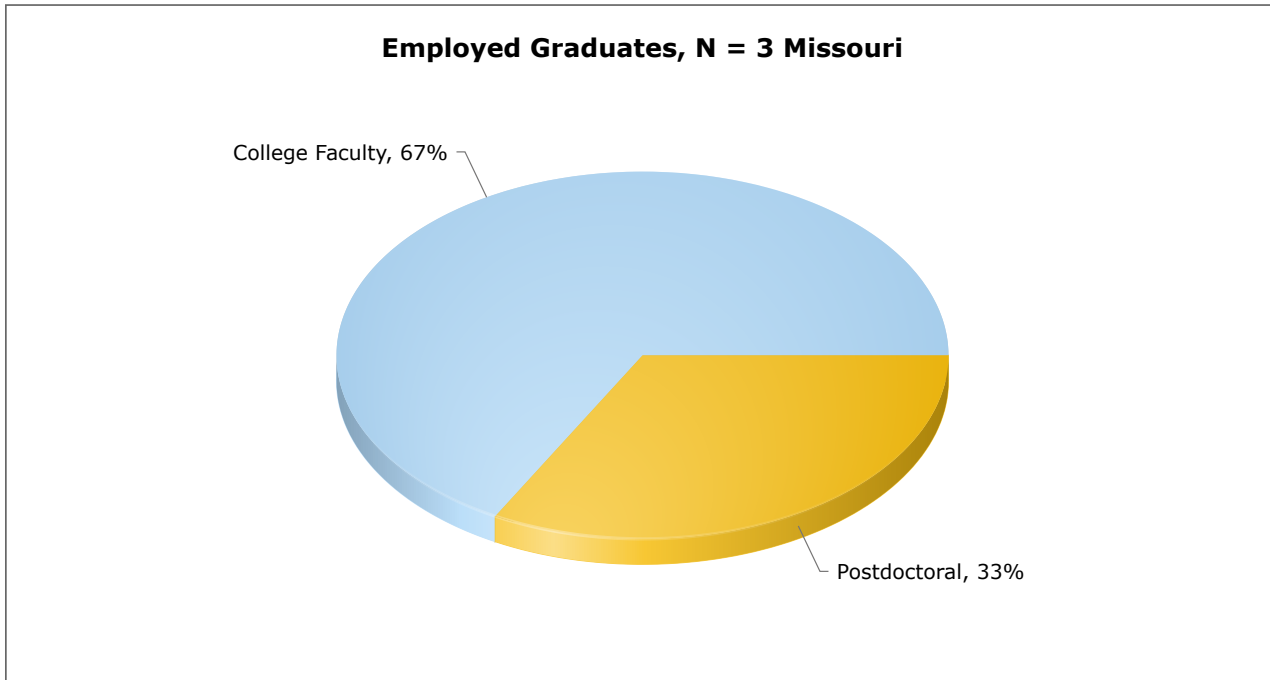

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Missouri Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 4 graduates (1 doctoral scholars; 3 dissertation scholars)
- 0 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 85 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.0 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 0.0 years for doctoral scholars (0.0 years average with master's degree; 0.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 34.3 years



- 100 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 100 percent are in higher education
- 33 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
