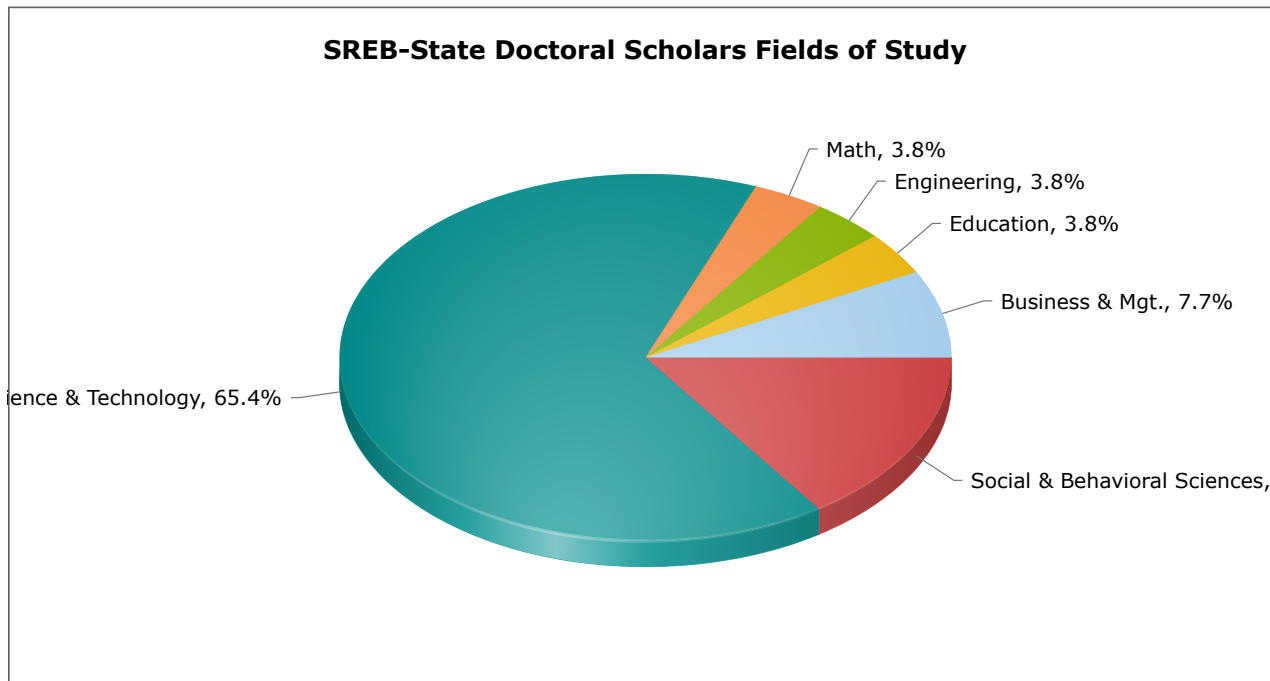

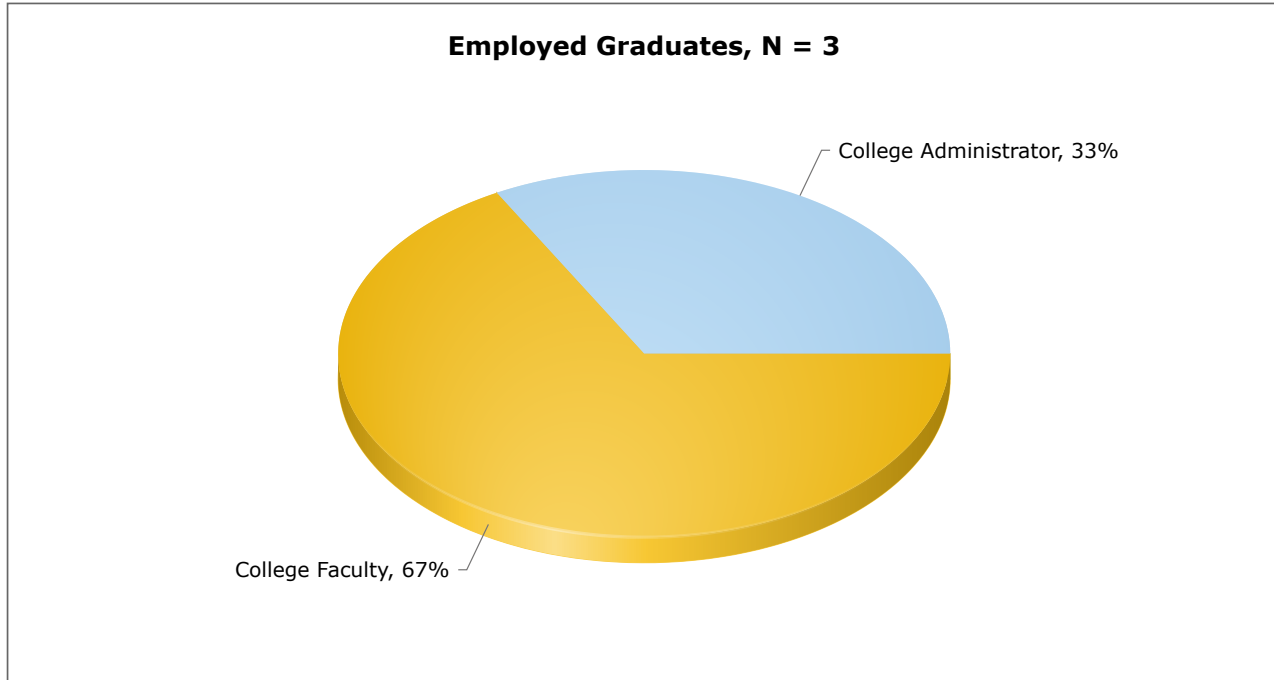

# SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program North Carolina Graduate Profile as of 01/15/20

- 3 graduates (1 doctoral scholars; 2 dissertation scholars)
- 35 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 35 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 0.7 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 3.9 years for doctoral scholars (3.9 years average with master's degree; 0.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 33.3 years



- 100 percent of graduates are employed in education
  - 100 percent are in higher education
- 100 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
