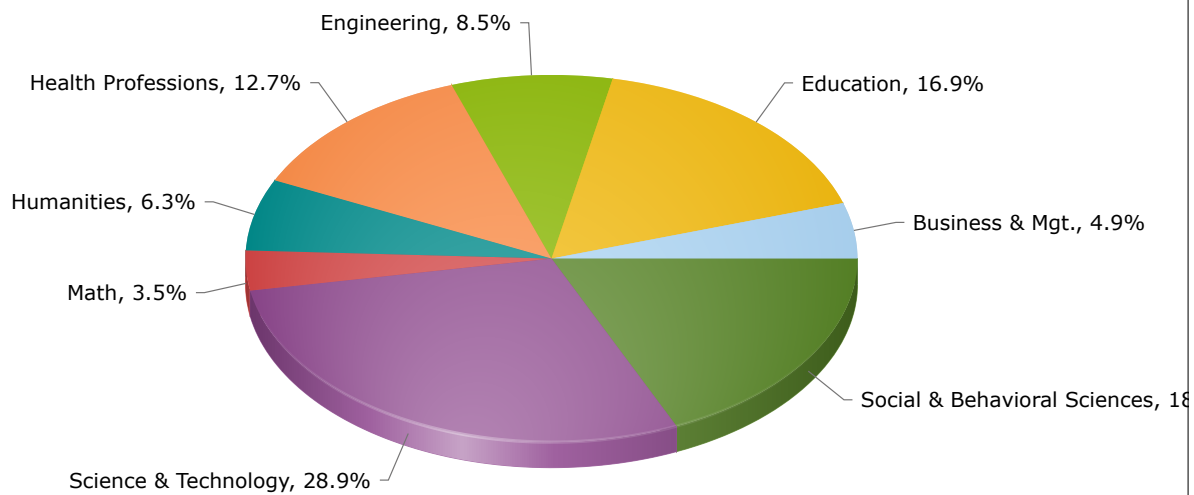

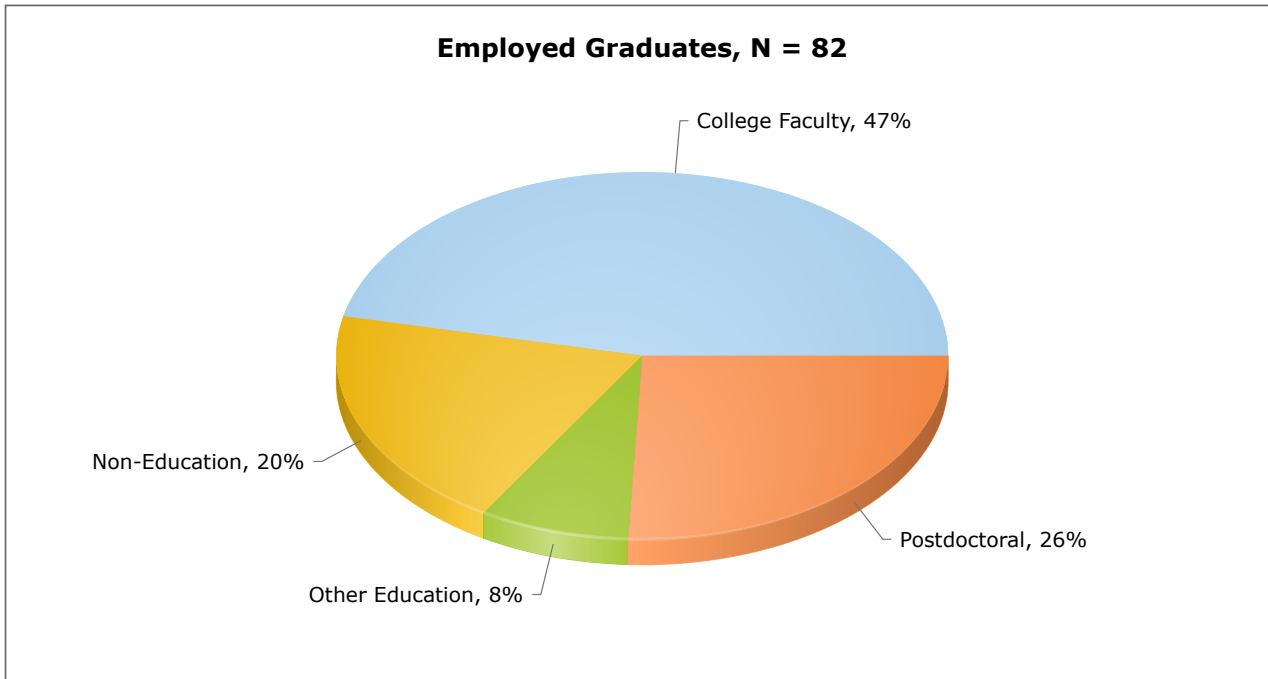

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program South Carolina Graduate Profile as of 01/15/20

- 96 graduates (55 doctoral scholars; 41 dissertation scholars)
- 22 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 65 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.3 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.5 years for doctoral scholars (4.5 years average with master's degree; 5.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 34.0 years



- 79 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 86 percent are in higher education
- 74 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
