


SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program South Carolina Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 114 graduates (62 doctoral scholars; 52 dissertation scholars)
- 24 percent received a bacccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 65 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.3 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.5 years for doctoral scholars (4.2 years average with master's degree; 4.9 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 33.4 years



• 78 percent of graduates are employed in education

87 percent are in higher education

• 73 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
