NORTH CAROLINA'S CHILD CARE LANDSCAPE

- 5,269 LICENSED CHILD CARE PROVIDERS
 - MOSTLY CHILD CARE CENTERS; ALSO FAMILY CHILD CARE HOMES
 - CURRENTLY SERVING:
 - 180.424 CHILDREN AGES 0 5
 - 40,577 SCHOOL-AGED CHILDREN CURRENTLY ENROLLED
- ~283,000 NC CHILDREN AGES 0 5 ARE NOT CURRENTLY IN LICENSED CARE






THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASE FOR CHILD CARE

- EMPOWERING WORK REPORT (OCT 2024)
 - NC COMMERCE & NC CHILD
 - AWARDED BEST POLICY ANALYSIS AWARD AT C2ER 2025 CONFERENCE
- METHODS
 - IDENTIFIED THAT IN 2023, THERE WERE 100,000 FEWER WORKING-AGE PARENTS WITH YOUNG CHILDREN IN NC'S WORKFORCE THAN IN 2019
 - PROJECTED IMPACTS OF UP TO 31,067 OF THESE INDIVIDUALS RETURNING TO THE WORKFORCE IN 2023



THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CASE FOR CHILD CARE • UPSHOT: EMPOWERING

- IN 2023, 31,000+ PARENTS REENTERING THE WORKFORCE WOULD HAVE CREATED:
 - UP TO \$13.3 BILLION IN ANNUAL ECONOMIC OUTPUT FOR NC
 - UP TO 68,000 NEW JOBS STATEWIDE
 - UP TO 37,150 OF THESE JOBS CREATED FROM DOWNSTREAM ECONOMIC IMPACTS
 - UP TO \$7.5 BILLION INCREASE IN NC'S GDP



EMPLOYER ENGAGEMENT OPTIONS

ON-SITE EMERGENCY BACKUP CHILD CARE

EMERGENCY CHILD CARE SERVICES OFFERED ON SITE WITHIN AN UPFITTED SPACE TO SERVE EMERGENCY CARE NEEDS FOR WORKERS WHOSE PRIMARY CHILD CARE ARRANGEMENT IS INTERRUPTED.

EMPLOYER ENGAGEMENT OPTIONS

CHILD CARE EXPANSION GRANTS

PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP ALLOWING EMPLOYERS TO SUPPORT ADDITION OF NEW CHILD CARE SLOTS IN EXISTING LICENSED CHILD CARE CENTERS.

BENEFITS

- WAITLIST PRIORITY FOR WORKERS
- ✓ EMPLOYERS CAN START AT ANY PRICE POINT
- ALL PARTICIPANTS CAN STICK TO CORE COMPETENCIES
- MORE SLOTS = SHORTER WAITLISTS FOR WHOLE COMMUNITY

- OBJECTIVE: EXPAND SUPPLY OF ACCESSIBLE,
 AFFORDABLE, AND HIGH-QUALITY CHILD CARE AND
 EARLY EDUCATION OPTIONS FOR WORKING
 FAMILIES IN NC



NORTH CAROLINA INNOVATION #2: TASK FORCE ON CHILD CARE & EARLY EDUCATION

TASK FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS (JUNE 2025):

- 1. SET A STATEWIDE CHILD CARE SUBSIDY REIMBURSEMENT RATE FLOOR
- 2. DEVELOP APPROACHES TO OFFER NON-SALARY BENEFITS TO CHILD CARE PROFESSIONALS
- 3. EXPLORE PARTNERSHIPS WITH THE UNC SYSTEM, NC COMMUNITY COLLEGES, AND K-12 SCHOOL SYSTEMS TO INCREASE ACCESS TO CHILD CARE FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES AND STUDENTS AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION
- 4. EXPLORE SUBSIDIZED OR FREE CHILD CARE FOR CHILD CARE TEACHERS
- 5. LINK EXISTING WORKFORCE COMPENSATION AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS FOR EARLY CHILDHOOD PROFESSIONALS INTO A COHESIVE SET OF SUPPORTS
- 6. EXPLORE THE CREATION OF A CHILD CARE ENDOWMENT TO FUND CHILD CARE NEEDS
