



SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Tennessee Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 92 graduates (45 doctoral scholars; 47 dissertation scholars)
- 39 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 82 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.9 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 4.3 years for doctoral scholars (4.2 years average with master's degree; 5.4 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 35.5 years



- 89 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 86 percent are in higher education
- 66 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
