



## SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program Virginia Graduate Profile as of 01/15/20

- 86 graduates (52 doctoral scholars; 34 dissertation scholars)
- 22 percent received a bacccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 76 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.6 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 5.3 years for doctoral scholars (5.3 years average with master's degree; 5.0 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 34.2 years



- 68 percent of graduates are employed in education
  96 percent are in higher education
- 61 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
