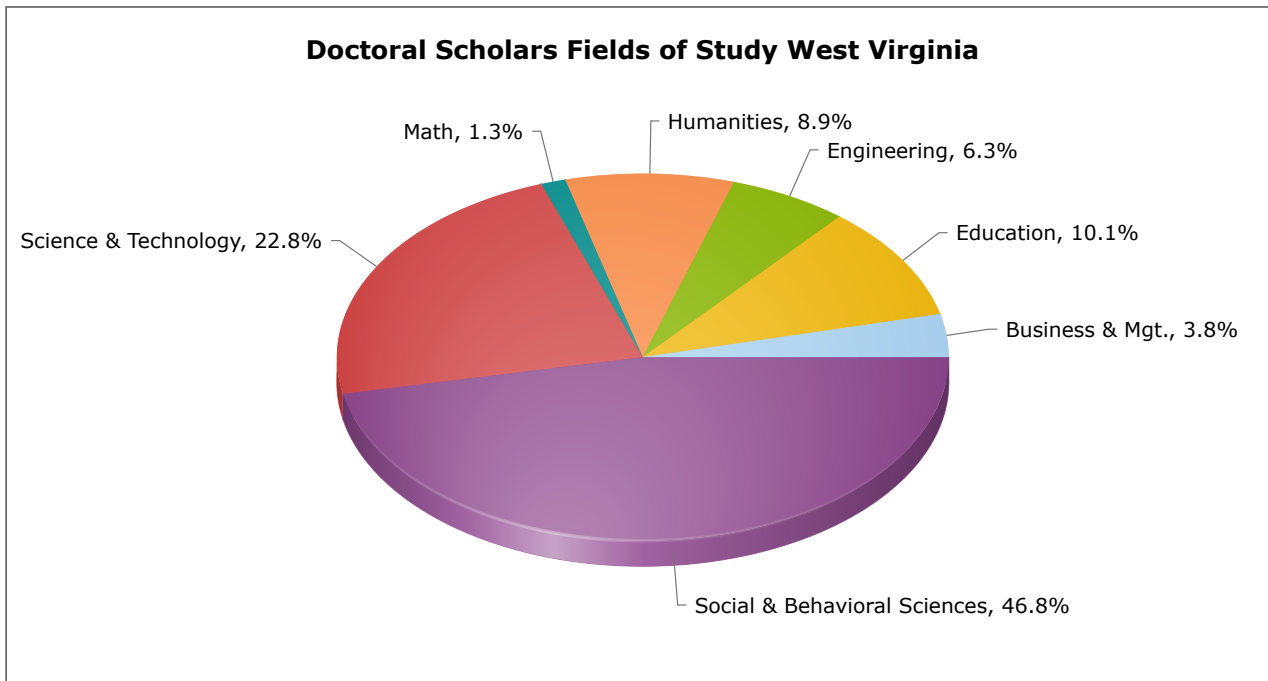

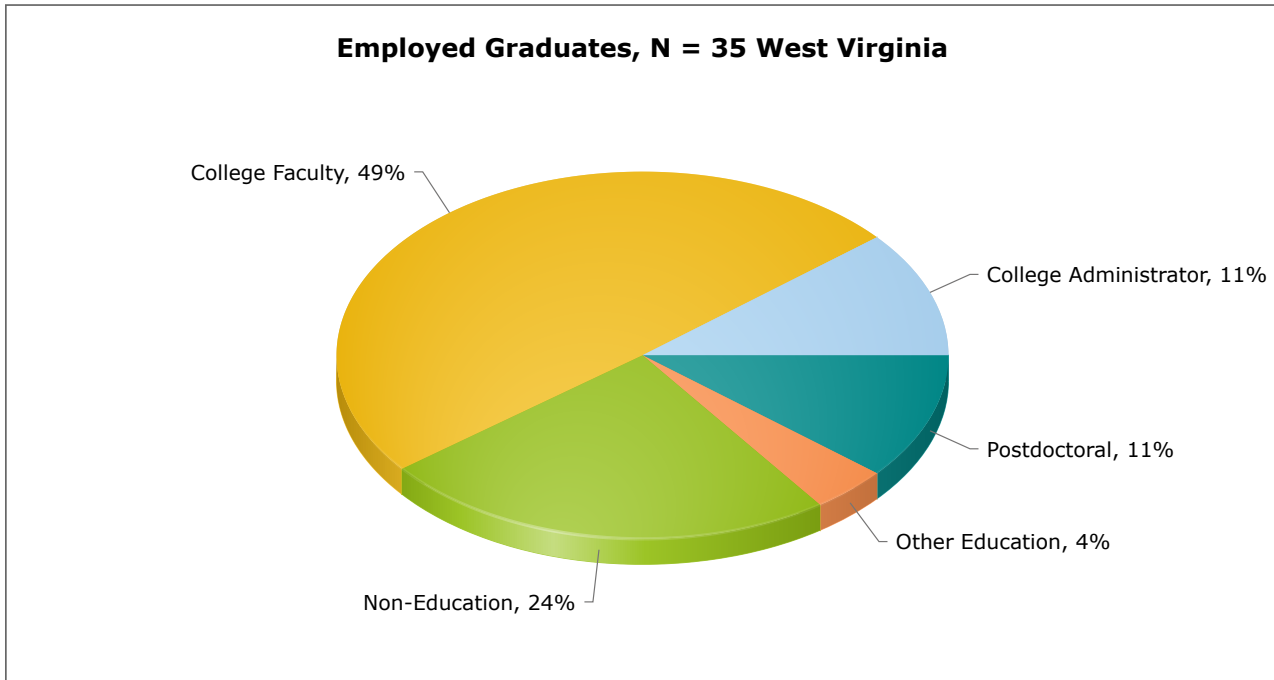

SREB-State Doctoral Scholars Program West Virginia Graduate Profile as of 01/15/21

- 46 graduates (33 doctoral scholars; 13 dissertation scholars)
- 15 percent received a baccalaureate degree from a historically black college or university
- 70 percent enter the program at a master's degree level or above
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 1.5 years for dissertation scholars
- Funded time-to-degree from program entrance averaged 5.2 years for doctoral scholars (5.6 years average with master's degree; 4.2 years without master's degree)
- Average age at graduation was 36.8 years



- 71 percent of graduates are employed in education
 - 96 percent are in higher education
- 60 percent of employed graduates are working in SREB states
